 Access to seasoned labor relations advisors: Benefit from confidential advice, listening, and professional support. This ensures the maintenance of a strong democratic structure and representation adapted to specific regional conditions.
- 3. Representation services: In the case of individual grievances, our association offers complete representation in arbitration tribunals, including appearances and negotiations with the employer. Collectively, our association is present on all platforms and represents you in all forums to defend your rights and advocate for improvements in your working conditions and practice. We have participated in all the work surrounding the Renewal of your working conditions. Similarly, we are continuously present on all committees related to your insurance, retirement plan, compensation, development, and training, etc. AGESSS has also participated in parliamentary committees, notably regarding the creation of Santé Québec, has filed requests before the courts alone to defend officers' right to association, has assisted hundreds of managers in filing disagreement notices to assert their rights, and continues to exert pressure on political authorities in this regard.
